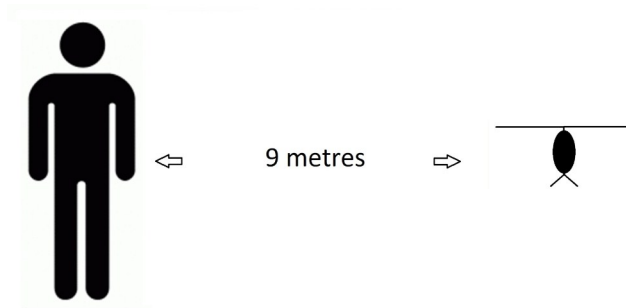
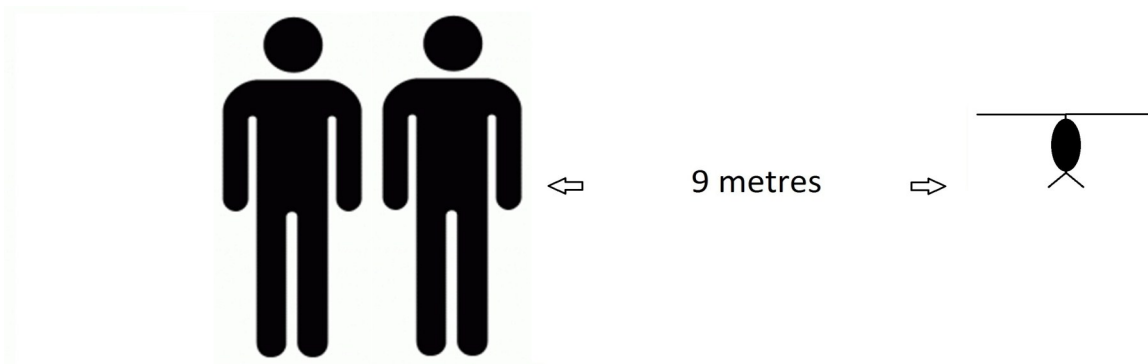


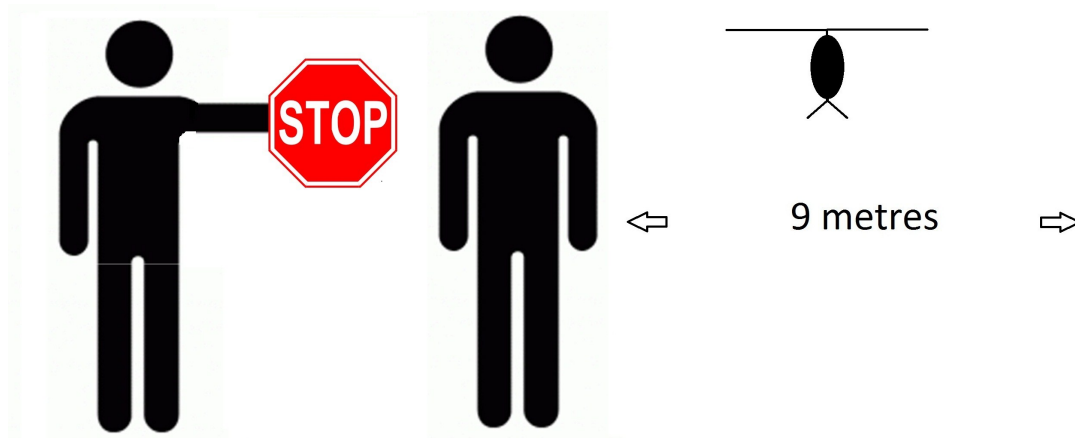
HELICOPTER FLIGHT SAFETY REMINDER



1. **DON'T BE A FOOL, OBSERVE THE 9 METRE RULE** – MAAA MOP014 6.5 Helicopter Flying: The MAAA requires that helicopters flying outdoors are not to be flown any closer than 9 metres to all pilots operating at the time.



2. **IT'S GREAT WHEN YOU FLY WITH A MATE** – Avoid flying alone, always fly with a mate. If something does happen, there is someone there to help.



3. **IF IN DOUBT, CALL IT OUT** – If you see a pilot do something you think is unsafe, approach the pilot and ask them to stop flying in that manner. If the pilot doesn't like this approach, refer him to your club committee and let them take action.
